

Students enrolled in online programs should first contact the specific department offering their program to inquire about how individual course registrations will be processed. Some online programs will automatically register students in individual courses, while others will require the student to register through the KSU WIRED system.

On campus students who are currently enrolled in traditional classes and/or distance education programs may review the list of available online courses by visiting the WIRED system to perform a class search. Students should consult with their assigned online advising coordinator as to what would apply to their particular degree.

It is also possible for undergraduate students not currently admitted to the University (such as students seeking a degree at another university) to take individual courses under Visiting Student status.
