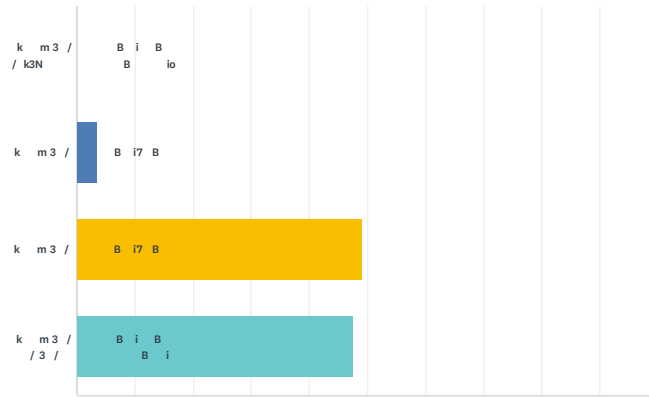

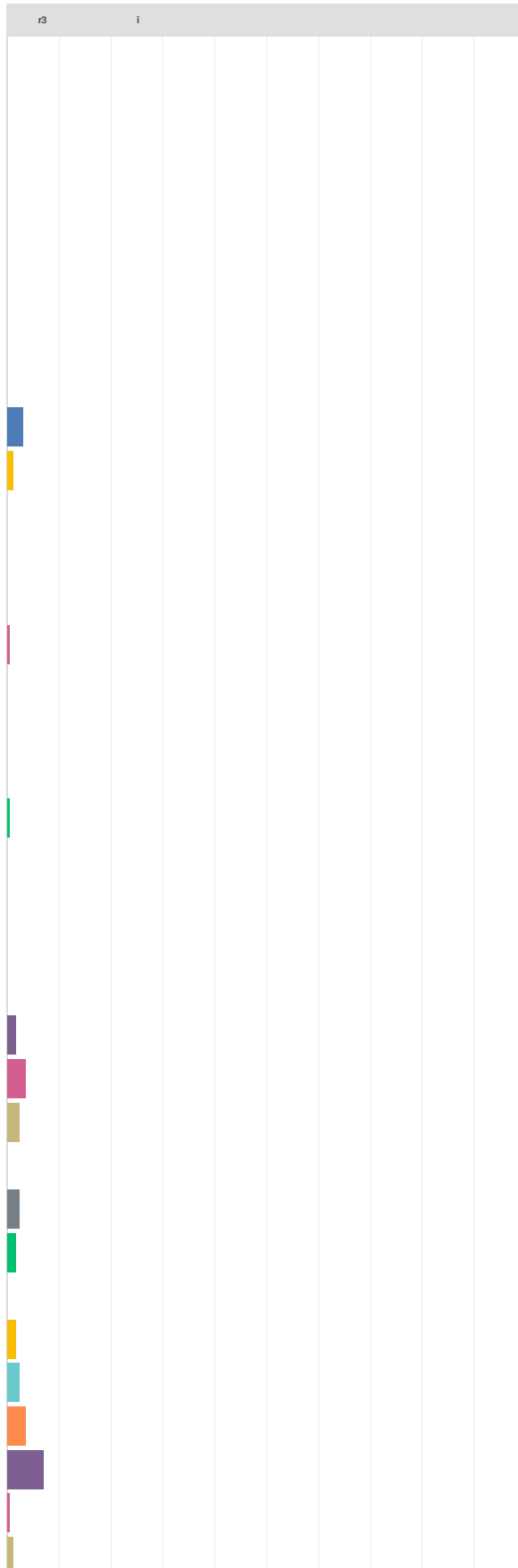
Q7 What was your student classification when you first enrolled at KSU?

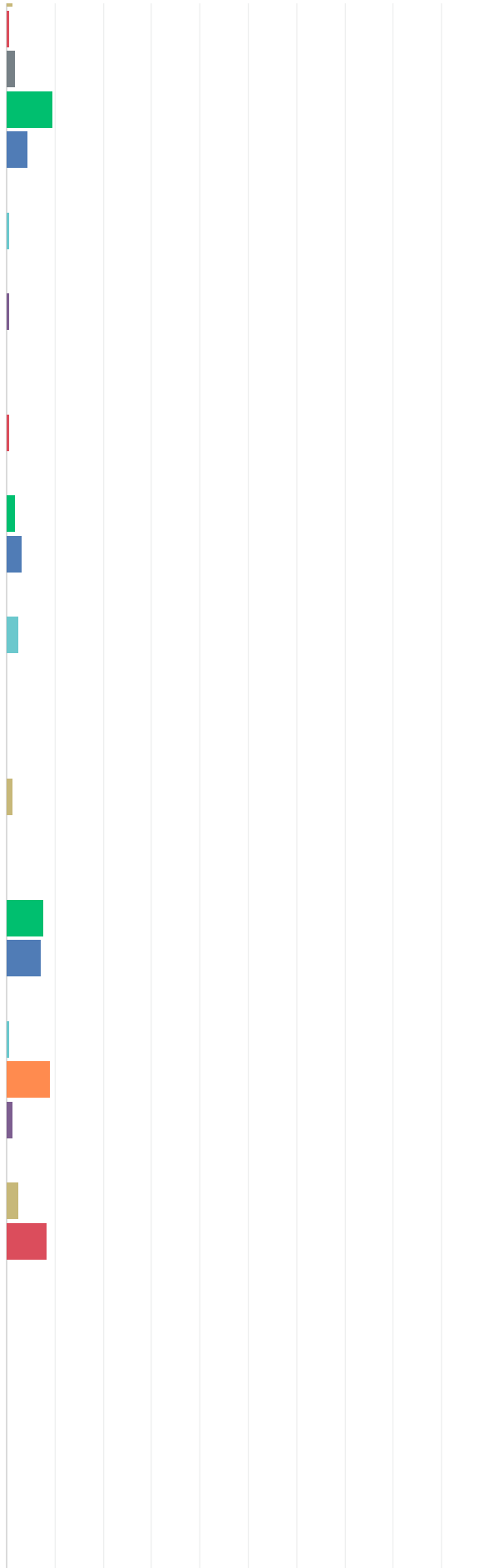

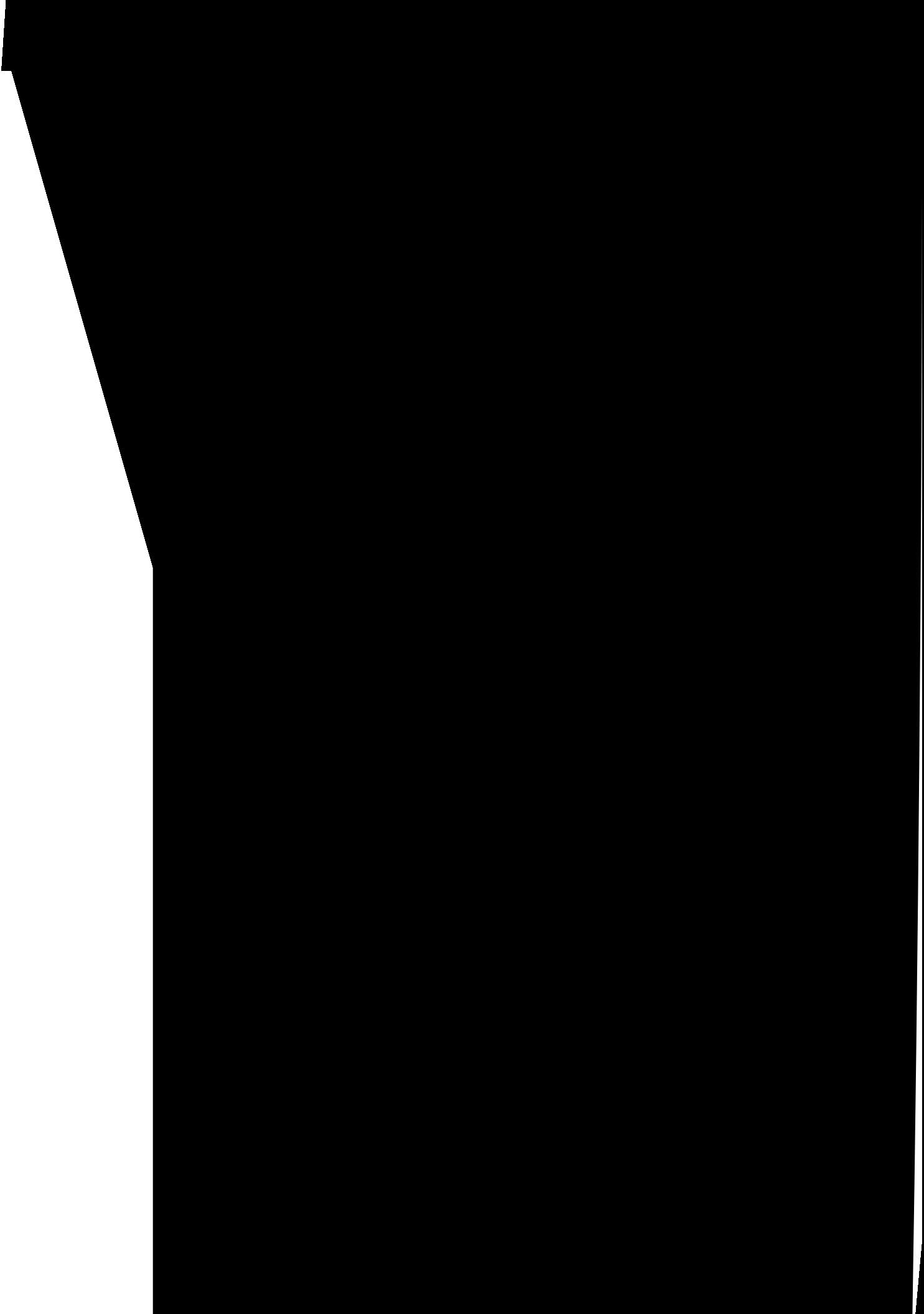

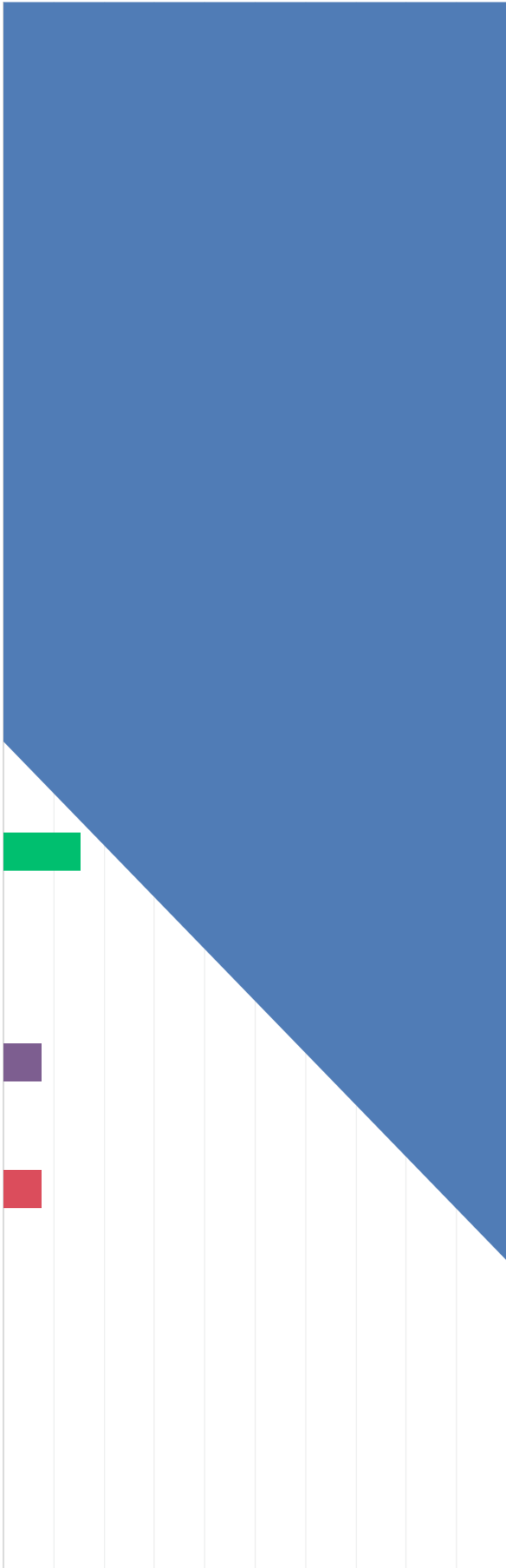
Q10 What was your bachelors at KSU this term?

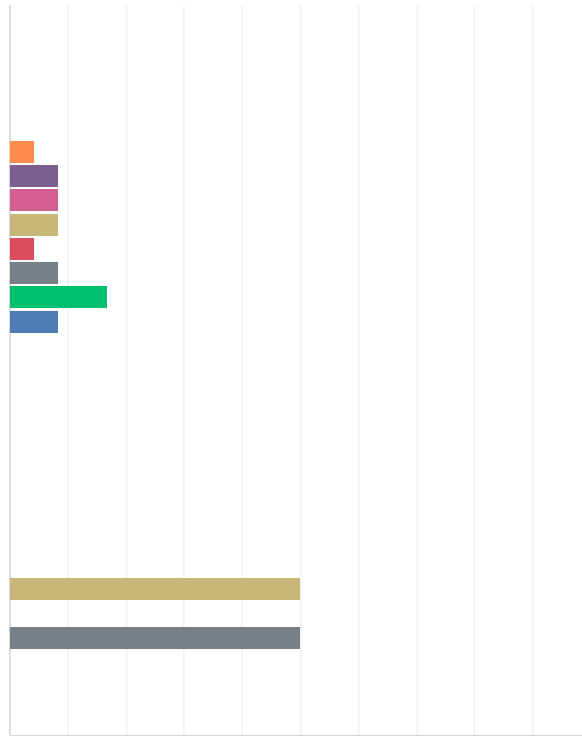


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Q11 What was your master's degree at KSU this term?

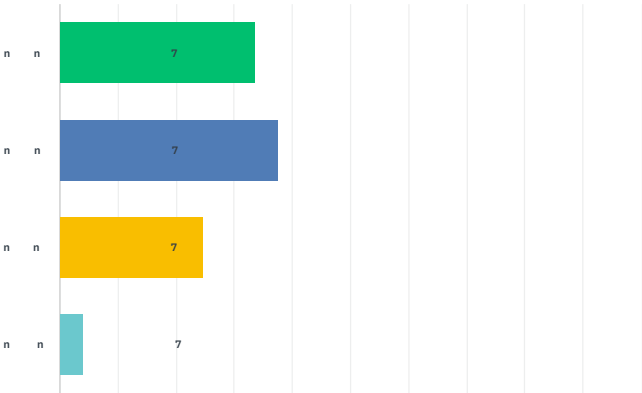

Q13 What was your overall GPA?

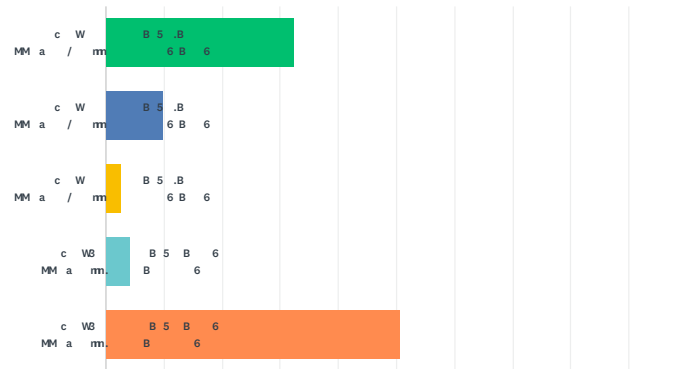

Q20 Which of the following best describes the current state of your educational activity?

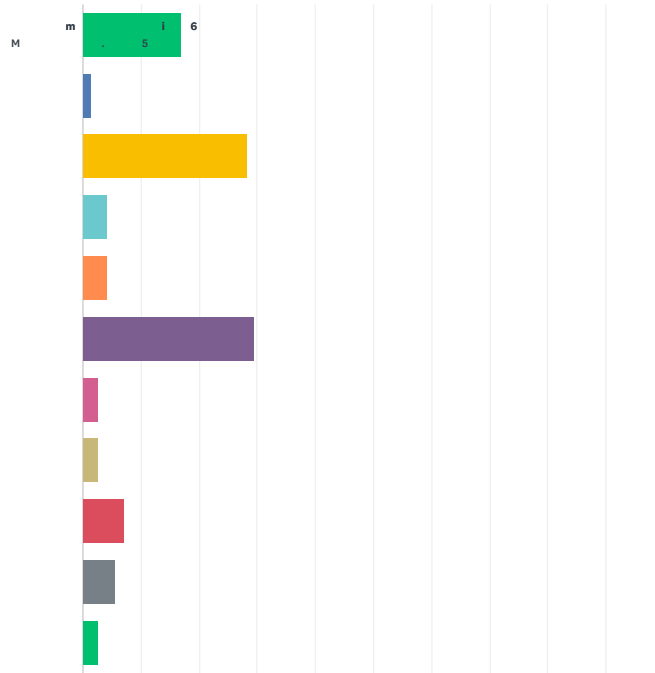

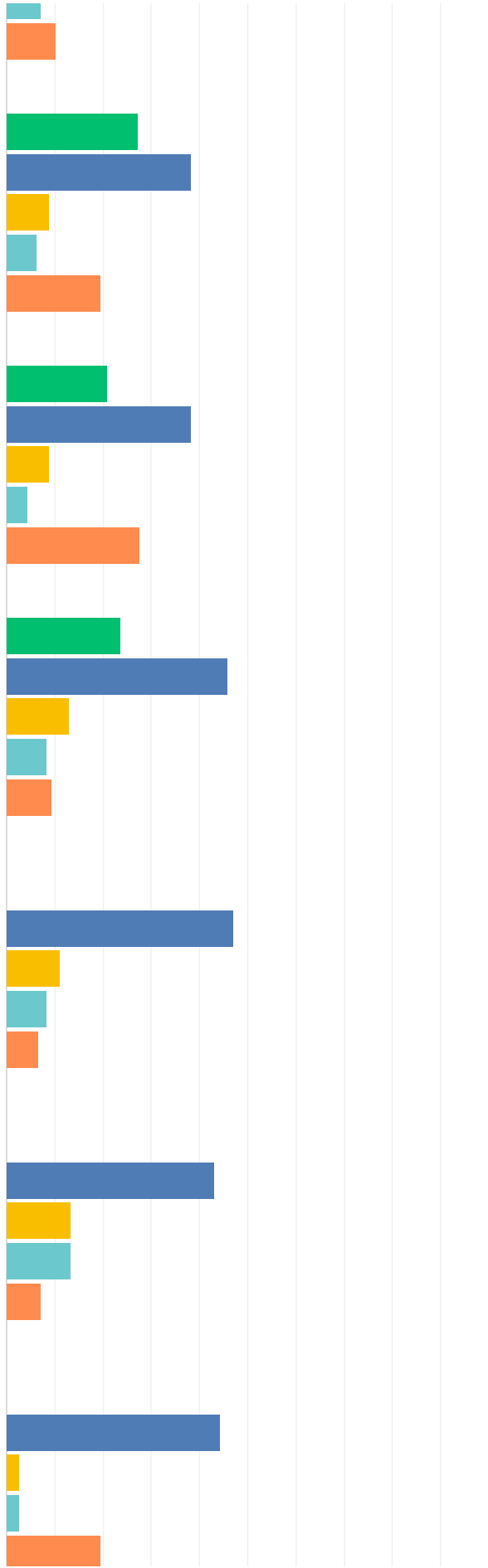




Q31 Indicate your level of satisfaction with the following aspects of your education at KSU

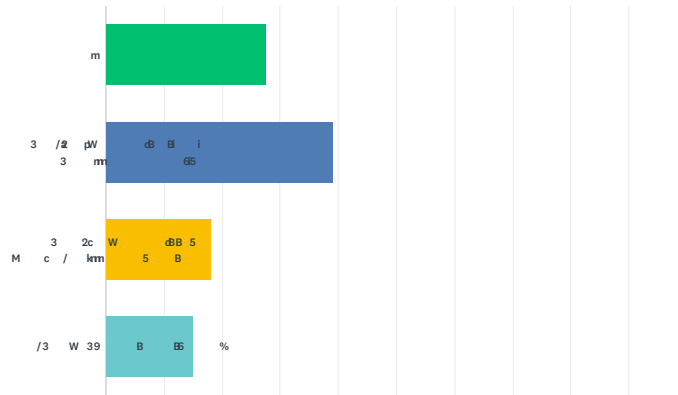

Q32 Would you continue your education at KSU?

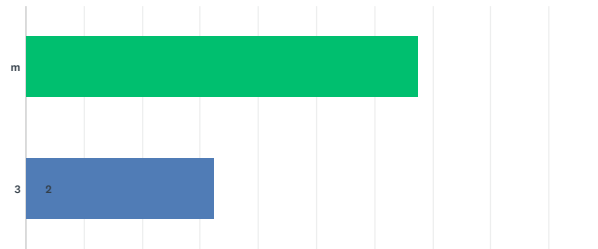
